NOW, THEREFORE, if the said Principal shall promptly file with the State Department of Revenue of the State of Alabama true reports, as required by law and shall pay all taxes, penalties, and interest imposed by the State of Alabama, and which may now be due or which may hereafter become due by the Principal to the State of Alabama, together with any and all penalties and interest thereon, and shall faithfully comply with the provisions of said Title 40, Chapter 17, Article 12, supra; then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise the same shall remain in full force and effect.

In the event that the Principal herein is required to pay the wholesale oil license fee provided under Title 40, Chapter 17, Article 4, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, this bond shall also specifically guarantee the payment to the State Department of Revenue of any amounts due by said Principal to said Department as to the license levied by said Code Section, and shall also insure the State Department of Revenue against any losses occasioned by Principal's failure to comply with any of the provisions thereof.

This bond shall be effective on _____ and is a continuing bond. The Surety on this bond may be released and discharged from any and all liability to the State of Alabama accruing on this bond after the expiration of thirty (30) days from the date upon which the State of Alabama Department of Revenue has provided written notice to the Principal that the Surety would be released and discharged; provided however, such request shall not operate to relieve, discharge, or release such Surety from any liability already accrued or which shall accrue before the expiration of said thirty (30) day period.
