Records to clearly substantiate the above petition must be maintained by the credit card issuer for a period of six years and must be made available to the Alabama Department of Revenue or its authorized agents upon request. The statute of limitations is two years from the date the credit card purchase was made by the licensed federal government exempt entity. The petition must be filed on a quarterly basis with a separate petition for each quarter and cannot include any purchases for any other period. A listing of purchases must be attached stating the date of the credit card purchase made by the licensed federal government exempt entity, the licensed federal government exempt entity name, exempt license number, vendor name and location, invoice number, product type, and number of gasoline and/or undyed diesel fuel gallons. Credit Card Issuer Petition for Refund – Federal Government

WHO MAY FILE. A credit card issuer who bills a licensed federal government exempt entity as listed in Section 40-17-329(e) without the state excise tax for gasoline and/or undyed diesel fuel purchased by a licensed federal government exempt entity at a fixed retail pump available to the public with the issuer's credit card.

WHEN TO FILE. The petition must be filed on a quarterly basis with a separate petition for each quarter and cannot include any purchases for any other period. The statute of limitations for filing a refund is within two (2) years from the date that the fuel was purchased by the exempt entity using the issuer's credit card.

WHERE TO FILE. The claim must be filed with the Alabama Department of Revenue, Business & License Tax Division, Motor Fuels Section, P.O. Box 327540, Montgomery, AL 36132-7540.

TAX REFUND CALCULATION.

1. Enter the total number of gasoline and/or undyed diesel fuel gallons billed to the licensed federal government exempt entity without the excise tax.
2. The state excise tax rate on gasoline is \$0.18 and on undyed diesel fuel is \$0.19.
3. Multiply the total number of gallons by the excise tax rate to compute the refund total.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED. A listing/report of purchases by licensed federal government exempt entities must be attached to the petition for refund. The listing/report must include the date of credit card purchases made by the licensed exempt entity, licensed federal government exempt entity name, federal government exempt license number, name of vendor and location, invoice number, product type, and the number of gasoline and/or undyed diesel fuel gallons billed by the credit card issuer without the tax.

APPEAL PROCEDURES. According to Section 40-2A-7, *Code of Alabama 1975*, you may appeal a denial of this claim within two years of written notice of denial by filing a notice of appeal with the Alabama Tax Tribunal, 2 North Jackson Street, Suite 301, Montgomery, AL 36104. You have the option of appealing to the Circuit Court in Montgomery County, Alabama, or to the Alabama Circuit Court of the county in which you reside or have a principal place of business. Please provide a copy of the appeal to this office.

PENALTIES. Any applicant who willfully files an inaccurate petition or false claim for a refund shall be subject to a penalty of 100 percent (100%) of the refund claimed, plus interest.
