SUBJECT: MLI Administrative Rule Update

Effective August 21, 2015, Revenue's Administrative Rule 810-5-8-.10 has been updated to require non-use documentation from registrants who claim their vehicles were stored or inoperable on the insurance verification date. In accordance with Administrative Rule 810-5-1-.244, prior to re-registering the vehicle, a registrant claiming their vehicle was stored or inoperable must provide evidence of the vehicle's non-use to the licensing official. The Motor Vehicle Affidavit (form MV IRP-15) may be utilized to satisfy this requirement or any documentation the official's office deems appropriate. Page 14 of the MLI Procedures Manual has been updated to reflect this rule change. The updated manual is available on the Motor Vehicle Division webpage: Reference and Statistics/ Manuals/ MLI Procedures Manual – August 21, 2015 (<http://revenue.alabama.gov/motorvehicle/pdf/MLIProceduresManual.pdf>). The revocation notice has been updated to include language notifying registrants who indicate that their vehicle was stored or inoperable on the insurance verification date that they must provide evidence of the vehicle's non-use to the licensing official prior to re-registering the vehicle.
