Alabama Business Privilege Tax Extension Granted to Limited Liability Entities

Montgomery, March 3, 2000 In an order issued today, Alabama Commissioner of Revenue George E. Mingle dorff III granted an automatic filing extension to limited liability entities in the reporting and payment of the Alabama Business Privilege Tax, due March 15, 2000.

According to the March 3, 2000, extension order, limited liability entities will have through April 17, 2000, to file the new Alabama Business Privilege Tax return (Form PSA) and pay the tax that would have been due March 15, 2000, without penalty.

This automatic filing extension applies only to limited liability entities and applies only to the Alabama Business Privilege Tax, said Mingle dorff. The department recognizes that the approaching March 15, 2000, filing and payment date has created a severe hardship for many limited liability entities to comply with the new Business Privilege Tax, as this is the first time that such business entities have become subject to such an extensive annual filing and reporting requirement, explained Mingle dorff.
