The governing body of the City of White Hall has adopted Resolution No. 2015-3-1 discontinuing the services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales/use taxes and any other additional taxes for the City of White Hall. This Resolution is effective July 1, 2015.

Therefore, your last City of White Hall sales tax return filed with the Alabama Department of Revenue is for the tax period ending June 30, 2015 due on or before July 20, 2015.

Resolution No. 2015-3-1

Whereas, Town of White Hall, Alabama desires to begin self-collection and administration of Town Sales/Use Tax and any other additional taxes effective beginning the period of July 1, 2015 (with the first collection to be received on or before August 20, 2015); and


Whereas, Town of White Hall, Alabama has been presented a proposal by RDS of Birmingham dated April 2, 2015 whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the Town and the Town desires to accept such proposal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of White Hall Council that the Town agrees to begin collecting Town sales/use tax effective beginning with the period of July 1, 2015 and the Mayor is instructed to notify the State of Alabama Department of Revenue immediately of the decision of this Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposal presented by RDS dated April 2, 2015, whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the Town, be accepted and the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter a contract with RDS which conforms to such proposal.


