Enclosed please find Resolution No. 326 passed by the Council of the TOWN OF BUTLER, Alabama. Effective beginning with the period of **OCTOBER 1, 2015**, the TOWN OF BUTLER will begin collecting its own Sales/Use Tax and Rental Tax,.

It is understood that the period of **October 1, 2015** taxes will be remitted locally on or before **November 20, 2015**.

A request for the tax payment history and taxpayer information for the TOWN OF BUTLER on diskette is being sent to Ms. Darcee Andrews in Information Processing.

We request from your office any pertinent information regarding the TOWN OF BUTLER tax accounts, including but not limited to:

- 1) Gross revenues, fees and net revenues processed from October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2015
- 2) Monthly payment listings for payments filed to state in error after October 1, 2015.
- 3) Delinquencies
- 4) Bankruptcies
- 5) Direct pay permits
- 6) NSF's
- 7) Audits in progress, etc.

The above information should be sent to Ms. Connie Taylor at RDS, 600 Beacon Parkway West, Suite 900, Birmingham, Alabama 35209 and she is authorized to contact your office concerning this matter on behalf of TOWN OF BUTLER. *We request that this information be sent to them by October 1, 2015.*

# Resolution No. 326

Whereas, Town of Butler, Alabama desires to begin self-collection and administration of Town Sales/Use Tax and Rental Tax and any other additional taxes effective beginning the period of October 1, 2015 (with the first collection to be received on or before November 20, 2015); and

Whereas, Town of Butler, Alabama has been presented a proposal by RDS of Birmingham dated August 11, 2015 whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the Town and the Town desires to accept such proposal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Butler Council that the Town agrees to begin collecting Town sales/use tax effective beginning with the period of October 1, 2015 and the Mayor is instructed to notify the State of Alabama Department of Revenue immediately of the decision of this Council; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposal presented by RDS dated August 11, 2015, whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the Town, be accepted and the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter a contract with RDS which conforms to such proposal.

THEREFORE, Ron Mason, a Council member, made the motion and Phil Pope, a Council member, seconded the motion that said resolution be approved, and said resolution passed by majority vote of the Council, and the Mayor declared the Resolution so passed.
