TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS making sales at retail and/or purchasing tangible personal property for use, storage or other consumption; engaging in the business of leasing or renting tangible personal property; engaging in the renting or furnishing of rooms, lodgings, or accommodations made to transients, in the City of Midway, Alabama and its police jurisdiction (located in Bullock County).

Article 3, Chapter 51, Title 11, et seq., Code of Alabama, 1975 authorizes and empowers municipalities to levy a true sales, use, rental and lodgings tax identical to the corresponding State Tax Laws except for the rates of tax.

The governing body of the City of Midway has adopted Resolution No. 2015-01 to commence services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales/use taxes and any other additional taxes for the City of Midway. This Resolution is effective April 01, 2015.

Therefore, your first City of Midway local tax return filed with Alabama Department of Revenue is for the tax period ending April 30, 2015, which is due on or before May 20, 2015. Please remit the City of Midway's local tax to:

The Law requires that Midway local taxes be collected, reported and remitted in the same manner as the State sales, use, rental and lodgings taxes. When you file and pay electronically, the City of Midway local taxes are to be included on the electronic city/county tax return assigned to you (City and County Form 9501). Enter the gross amounts and deductions and then all of the calculations will be done automatically for you. COLLECT SALES AND USE TAXES  
LEVIED BY THE TOWN OF MIDWAY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIDWAY, AS  
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1: Administration and Collection by State Department of Revenue. Pursuant to the provisions of Code of Alabama 1975, Section 11-51-207, the Town Council of the Town of Midway hereby directs that the Department of Revenue of the State of Alabama shall administer and collect all *sales and use* taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution to the fullest extent allowed by Alabama law.

SECTION 2: The Town of Midway shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Alabama Department of Revenue and shall also provide such other information and take such other steps as may be required by said Department of Revenue to enable it to administer and collect taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution.

The Town Council of the Town of Midway adopted this Resolution at the regular meeting on March 2, 2015. This Resolution is effective as of April 1, 2015.
