ORDINANCE NO. 2011-11

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2008-37 IN REFERENCE TO CHAPTER 13, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA, ARTICLE VI A. HOTELS AND MOTELS, SECTION 13.73 AND 13-74 RELATING TO ESTABLISHMENT OF HOTEL AND MOTEL LICENSE TAX.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHENIX CITY, ALABAMA, that the ordinances of the City of Phenix City, Alabama be amended to read as follows:

1. Section 13-73 entitled "License tax imposed-rate within corporate limits." shall be amended to increase license tax to nine (9) percent from seven (7) percent.
2. Section 13-74 entitled "License tax imposed-rate outside corporate limits but within police jurisdiction", shall be amended to increase the license tax to four and one-half (4 ½) percent from three and one-half (3 ½) percent.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect September 1, 2011 and that each and every provision of this ordinance is hereby declared to be an independent provision and the holding of any provision hereof to be void or invalid shall not affect any other provision hereof, and it is hereby declared that the other provisions of this ordinance would have been enacted regardless of any provision which might be held invalid.


