NOTICE

MY ALABAMA TAXES (MAT)

Effective February 28, 2011, taxpayers who file the Alabama Underground and Aboveground Storage Tank Trust Fund Charge return will be able to access the Department of Revenue's new internet portal called My Alabama Taxes, or MAT. MAT will provide taxpayers a wide range of online activities including online filing, viewing latest version of storage tank returns, amending returns, printing latest version of returns, making payments on available periods, viewing letters that have been sent from the Department, requesting a change of Name and Address, sending messages to/receiving messages from the Department, seeing period summary and balances for all available periods and seeing total balance of account. Effective July 1, 2011, all taxpayers will be required to file the storage tank return electronically using MAT. The internet link to access MAT is:

<https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov/>.

If you are a first time user of MAT, once you access MAT you will need to register. The link to register is located to the right of the "Logon" button on MAT's home page. In order to register, you will need your account number, sign-on id, and access code. The sign-on id and access code are only used once and that is during the registration process. If you do not know your sign-on id and access code, contact the Tobacco Tax Section at the address or telephone number shown below. *Note:* If you currently participate in MAT, you will **not** need to register again. However, you will need to Add Access to Another Account, which will be the Storage Tank account.

If you need help navigating through MAT, there is a Taxpayer Guide on MAT's home page that you may download and follow. There is also a link on the home page for "Frequently Asked Questions" that will be helpful to you.
