





 - If “unconfirmed” response received
 - Must view evidence of insurance

PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

An owner or operator convicted of a mandatory liability insurance violation may be fined by law enforcement as follows:

- First violation - up to \$500 fine.
- Second or subsequent violations - up to \$1,000 fine and/or a six-month driver license suspension.

In addition to the above violation, if a vehicle is registered or operated without liability insurance, the vehicle registration will be suspended and the vehicle owner will be subject to the following:

- First violation - \$200 reinstatement fee.
- Second or subsequent violations - \$400 reinstatement fee and a mandatory four-month registration suspension.

Evidence of current insurance must also be provided in order to reinstate the vehicle registration.

Evidence of current insurance, along with the reinstatement fee, may be submitted to the county license plate issuing official in the vehicle owner's county of residence, or any of the Alabama Department of Revenue Taxpayer Service Centers located throughout Alabama.

License plate issuing officials and law enforcement will utilize OIVS to immediately verify the liability insurance status of a vehicle. If insurance cannot be verified through OIVS, vehicle owners must provide evidence of insurance to the license plate issuing official.



OIVS Inquiry Structure





Insurance Advisory Council

- Act 2011-688 established the OIVS advisory council to:
 - Facilitate the implementation of the OIVS using the IICMVA model
 - Assist in the development of a detailed guide for insurers
 - Outline the testing phase and identify any changes
 - Issue a report to DOR, DPS and DOI



Insurance Advisory Council

- The council includes 13 members:
 - DOR (2)
 - DOI (1)
 - APJA (1)
 - AIA (1)
 - PCI (1)
 - DPS (1)
 - AATA (1)
 - 3 Insurance Reps.
 - NAMIC (1)
 - AIIA (1)
- The council has met monthly since July 2011.
- Council meeting minutes and agendas are posted to the DOR website.

Mandatory Liability Insurance

- Changes effective January 1, 2013:
 - Requirements of License Plate Issuing Officials (32-7A-17):
 - Registration suspended
 - Cannot process registration transaction
 - Reinstate registration upon request
 - Must verify insurance through OIVS or view evidence of insurance
 - Valid DL, non-driver ID or FEIN required for each vehicle owner



Mandatory Liability Insurance

- DOR use OIVS to verify insurance
 - receives notice of insurance convictions
 - DL suspensions
 - “unconfirmed” responses
- DOR periodically verifies
- If DOR cannot confirm insurance policy on vehicle
 - Questionnaire
 - Notice of suspension

The Alabama Mandatory Liability Insurance (MLI) Law provides that no person shall operate, register, or maintain registration of a motor



Complying With Law

Beginning January 1, 2013, license plate issuing officials will attempt to verify liability insurance utilizing the State of Alabama Online Insurance



Enforcement

The mandatory liability insurance law is enforced by the following methods:

- Verification of insurance by law



Violation Penalties

An owner or operator convicted of a mandatory liability insurance violation may be fined up to \$500 for the first violation and up to \$1,000 for the
