SUBJECT: Redesigned and New License Plates for Issuance Beginning May 2014

The Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum and Save the Saturn V distinctive passenger license plates have been redesigned and are currently being delivered to county offices for issuance beginning May 1, 2014. On May 1, 2014, all Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum and Save the Saturn V passenger license plates with the old design should be removed from your shelves and held for audit purposes. **NOTE: The Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum Motorcycle plates will not be replaced at this time and you will continue to issue your current stock of these plates.**

The Freshwater Fishing license plate has exceeded the minimum required number of pre-commitments and Alabama Correctional Industries (ACI) should begin delivering these plates to county offices by mid-April. These plates will only be shipped to the counties where pre-commitments were purchased in order to prevent overstocking your offices. **Issuance of these plates should begin May 1, 2014.**

Personalized license plates featuring the new designs may be ordered on the Plate Reservation and Ordering System (PROS) beginning May 1, 2014. The Barber Vintage Motorsports Museum personalized license plates now allow six (6) characters as required by the Legislative Oversight Committee (LOC) guidelines.
