- Primary Tag Type(s): MM (Pre-numbered)
- Secondary Tag Type(s):
 - 01 (Disability Access)
 - MC (Motorcycle Pre-numbered)
 - M1 (Motorcycle Disability)
- Series Began: January 2018

All residents of Alabama who are active, retired, or honorably discharged veterans of the U.S. Merchant Marine may purchase license plates in this category.

Required Documentation

One of the following documents must be presented to the license plate issuing official:

- Military ID
- Leave and Earnings Statement
- DD214
- Affidavit from Veteran Affairs

The Application for Disability Access Parking Privileges must be provided to obtain the disability access license plate.

The plates may **not** be personalized.

The distinctive license plate follows the owner and is not transferable.

This plate may be displayed upon the following types of vehicles:

- private passenger automobiles
- pickup trucks
- motorcycles
- pleasure motor vehicles (i.e., recreational vehicles)

The license plate design changes every five (5) years.

The surviving spouse of a veteran fitting this criteria may **not** obtain the plate.

The surviving spouse of a veteran fitting this criteria may **not** retain the plate.

There is no limit to the number of plates the registrant may obtain.

Individual plates are ordered On Demand through the Plate Reservation and Ordering System (PROS).

Fees

- Registration: \$15.00-\$890.00 depending on the type of vehicle registered
- Additional fees: \$3.00 in the years in which a metal plate is issued
- The net proceeds of the \$3 are distributed to base in accordance with the provisions of Sections 40-12-269 and 40-12-270, Code of Alabama.
