TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS making sales at retail and/or purchasing tangible personal property for use, storage or other consumption, in the Town of Akron, Alabama and its police jurisdiction (located in Hale County).

Article 3, Chapter 51, Title 11, et seq., Code of Alabama, 1975 authorizes and empowers municipalities to levy a true sales, use, rental and lodgings tax identical to the corresponding State Tax Laws except for the rates of tax.

The governing body of the Town of Akron has adopted Resolution No. 02072017 to commence services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales/use taxes for the Town of Akron. This Resolution is effective March 01, 2017.

Therefore, your first Town of Akron local tax return filed with Alabama Department of Revenue is for the tax period ending March 31, 2017, which is due on or before April 20, 2017. Please remit the Town of Akron's local tax to:

The Law requires that Akron local taxes be collected, reported and remitted in the same manner as the State sales and use taxes. When you file and pay electronically, the Town of Akron local taxes are to be included on the electronic city/county tax return assigned to you (City and County Form 9501). Enter the gross amounts and deductions and then all of the calculations will be done automatically for you.
