ORDINANCE NO. 2014-04

**AN ORDINANCE DISCONTINUING COLLECTION OF TAXES AND SERVICES IN THE POLICE JURISDICTION**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Town Council of the Town of Cedar Bluff, Alabama, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Town will discontinue the collection of all municipal taxes and fees in its police jurisdiction, including, but not restricted to, sales or gross receipt taxes, use taxes, business licenses, tobacco taxes, gasoline taxes, rental taxes and building permits.

**SECTION 2.** The Town will discontinue all services in its police jurisdiction.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall become effective at midnight on January 15, 2015.

**SECTION 4.** The Mayor is hereby directed to publicize the provisions of this ordinance before the ordinance becomes effective in order to afford persons in the police jurisdiction the opportunity to make preparation for substituted services well ahead of such change.

**SECTION 5.** The Town Clerk is hereby directed to furnish copies of this ordinance to the following: the Cherokee County Commission, the Sheriff of Cherokee County, the Cherokee County 9-1-1 District, Cherokee County Electric Co-Op and the State Department of Revenue.
