Chilton County Resolution

Resolution No. 2017-11-27

Whereas, Chilton County, Alabama desires to begin self-collection and administration of County Lodging Tax and any other additional taxes effective beginning the period of January, 2018 (with the first collection to be received on or before February 20, 2018); and

Whereas, Chilton County, Alabama has been presented a proposal by RDS of Birmingham dated July, 2017 whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the County and the County desires to accept such proposal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Chilton County Commission that the County agrees to begin collecting County lodging tax effective beginning with the period of January, 2018 and the ~~Mayor~~ Chairman is instructed to notify the State of Alabama Department of Revenue immediately of the decision of this Commission; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposal presented by RDS dated July, 2017, whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the County, be accepted and the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to enter a contract with RDS which conforms to such proposal.

THEREFORE, Steve Langston, a Commission member, made the motion and Jimmie Hardee, a Commission member, seconded the motion that said resolution be approved, and said resolution passed by majority vote of the Commission, and the Chairman declared the Resolution so passed.
