TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS making sales at retail and/or purchasing tangible personal property for use, storage or other consumption, in the Town of Gordo, Alabama and its police jurisdiction (located in Pickens County).

Article 3, Chapter 51, Title 11, et seq., Code of Alabama, 1975 authorizes and empowers municipalities to levy a true sales, use, rental and lodgings tax identical to the corresponding State Tax Laws except for the rates of tax.

The governing body of the Town of Gordo has adopted Resolution No. 02-2017 to commence services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales/use taxes for the Town of Gordo. This Resolution is effective July 01, 2017.

Therefore, your first Town of Gordo local tax return filed with Alabama Department of Revenue is for the tax period ending July 31, 2017, which is due on or before August 21, 2017. Please remit the Town of Gordo's local tax to:


The Law requires that Gordo local taxes be collected, reported and remitted in the same manner as the State sales and use taxes. When you file and pay electronically, the Town of Gordo local taxes are to be included on the electronic city/county tax return assigned to you (City and County Form 9501). Enter the gross amounts and deductions and then all of the calculations will be done automatically for you. You may file these taxes through My Alabama Taxes (MAT) at <https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov>. 
Be it further resolved that this agreement will begin on July 1, 2017 and will continue on a month to month basis as long as both parties are in agreement.
