Greene County Resolution

Resolution No 2018-12

Whereas, County of Greene County, Alabama desires to begin self -collection and administration of County, Lodging Tax effective beginning the period of August 1, 2018 (with the first collection to be received on or before September 20, 2018); and

Whereas, County of Greene County, Alabama has been presented a proposal by RDS of Birmingham dated December 18, 2017 whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the County and the County desires to accept such proposal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Greene County Commission that the County agrees to begin collecting County lodging effective beginning with the period of August 1, 2018, and the Chairman is instructed to notify the State of Alabama Department of Revenue immediately of the decision of this Commission; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposal presented by RDS dated December 18, 2017, whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the County, be accepted and the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with RDS which conforms to such proposal.

THEREFORE, Lester Brown, a Commission member, made the motion and Michael Williams, a Commission member, seconded the motion that said resolution be approved, and said resolution passed by majority vote of the Commission, and the Chairman declared the Resolution so passed.
