TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS making sales at retail and/or purchasing tangible personal property for use, storage or other consumption; engaging in the business of leasing or renting tangible personal property; engaging in the renting or furnishing of rooms, lodgings, or accommodations made to transients, in the City of Hartselle, Alabama (located in Morgan County).

Article 3, Chapter 51, Title 11, et seq., Code of Alabama, 1975 authorizes and empowers municipalities to levy a true sales, use, rental and lodgings tax identical to the corresponding State Tax Laws except for the rates of tax.

The governing body of the City of Hartselle has adopted Resolution No. 17- 0425 to commence services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales/use taxes and any other additional taxes for the City of Hartselle. This Resolution is effective July 01, 2017.

Therefore, your first City of Hartselle local tax return filed with Alabama Department of Revenue is for the tax period ending July 31, 2017, which is due on or before August 21, 2017. Please remit the City of Hartselle's local tax to:

The Law requires that Hartselle local taxes be collected, reported and remitted in the same manner as the State sales, use, rental and lodgings taxes. When you file and pay electronically, the City of Hartselle local taxes are to be included on the electronic city/county tax return assigned to you (City and County Form 9501). Enter the gross amounts and deductions and then all of the calculations will be done automatically for you. RESOLUTION 17-0425

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALABAMA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO ADMINISTER AND COLLECT SALES, USE, RENTAL, AND LODGINGS TAXES LEVIED BY THE CITY OF HARTSELLE, ALABAMA

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HARTSELLE CITY COUNCIL OF HARTSELLE,
ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Administration and Collection by Alabama Department of Revenue. Pursuant to the provisions of the Code of Alabama 1975, Section 11-51-207, the Hartselle City Council of Hartselle, Alabama hereby directs that the Department of Revenue of the State of Alabama shall administer and collect all sales, use, rental, and lodgings taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution to the fullest extent allowed by Alabama law.

SECTION 2. Certified Copy. The City of Hartselle shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Alabama Department of Revenue and shall also provide such other information and take such other steps as may be required by said Department of Revenue to enable it to administer and collect taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution.

The City of Hartselle adopted this Resolution at the regular meeting on April 25, 2017. This Resolution is effective as of July 1, 2017.
