

WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln desires to become self-administered effective January 1, 2020; and


WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln shall provide a certified copy of this resolution to the Alabama Department of Revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby adopt this resolution this the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of October, 2019.


