The City of Luverne has increased their use taxes general rate as shown below:

Use Taxes:	<u>OLD</u> <u>RATES</u>	<u>NEW</u> <u>RATES</u>
General Rate	2.00%	2.50%

If sales of tangible personal property are made or delivered, or if purchases of tangible personal property are stored, used or consumed, outside the corporate limits of the city but within the police jurisdiction of the city, the rates of tax are one-half of those stated above.

This ordinance amends Article VII Gross Receipts or Sales, Sec. 10-7-4 (a) as follows:


Article VII. GROSS RECEIPTS OR SALES.

Sec. 10-7-4.


(a) An excise tax is hereby imposed on the storage, use or other consumption in The City of Luverne of tangible personal property (not including materials and supplies bought for use in fulfilling a contract for the painting, repairing or reconditioning of vessels, barges, ships and other watercraft of more than fifty tons burden) purchased at retail on or after the effective date of this ordinance for storage, use or other consumption in The City of Luverne, except as provided in subsection (b), (c), and (d), at the rate of two and one half percent (2 ½ %) of the sales price of such property within the corporate limits of said City.

This ordinance shall become effective on the 1st day of September, 2019.

Sec. 10-7-4.

(a) An excise tax is hereby imposed on the storage, use or other consumption in The City of Luverne of tangible personal property (not including materials and supplies bought for use in fulfilling a contract for the painting, repairing or reconditioning of vessels, barges, ships and other watercraft of more than fifty tons burden) purchased at retail on or after the effective date of this ordinance for storage, use or other consumption in The City of Luverne, except as provided in subsection (b), (c), and (d), at the rate of two and one half percent (2 ½ %) of the sales price of such property within the corporate limits of said City.
