TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS engaged in the renting or furnishing of rooms, lodgings or accommodations to transients in the **City of Sylacauga**, Alabama (located in Talladega County)

Article 3, Chapter 51, Title 11, et seq., Code of Alabama, 1975 authorizes and empowers municipalities to levy a true sales, use, rental and lodgings tax identical to the corresponding State Tax Laws except for the rates of tax.

The governing body of the City of Sylacauga has adopted Resolution No. 30-2016 to commence services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the lodgings taxes for the City of Sylacauga. This Resolution is effective September 01, 2016. Therefore, your first City of Sylacauga lodgings tax return filed with the Alabama Department of Revenue will be for the month of September 2016, which is due on or before October 20, 2016. The tax rate is as follows:

Lodgings Tax Rate..... 9%

The Law requires that City of Sylacauga lodgings tax be collected, reported and remitted in the same manner as the State lodgings tax. When you file and pay electronically, the City of Sylacauga lodgings tax is to be included on the electronic local tax return assigned to you (City and County Tax Return, form 9501). Simply enter the gross amounts and deductions, and all calculations will be done automatically for you. You may file these taxes through My Alabama Taxes (MAT) at <https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov>.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SYLACAUGA, AS
FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1: Administration and Collection by State Department of Revenue. Pursuant to the provisions of **Code of Alabama 1975, Section 11-51-207**, the City Council of the City of Sylacauga hereby directs that the Department of Revenue of the State of Alabama shall administer and collect all lodgings taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution to the fullest extent allowed by Alabama law.

SECTION 2: The City of Sylacauga shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Alabama Department of Revenue and shall also provide such other information and take such other steps as may be required by said Department of Revenue to enable it to administer and collect taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution.

The City Council of the City of Sylacauga adopted this Resolution at the regular meeting on 3rd of August, 2016. This Resolution shall be effective as of the date of its passage by the City Council, with the Administration and Collection services by the State Department of Revenue beginning October 1, 2016.




