The governing body of the City of Tallassee has adopted Resolution No. 2018-576 discontinuing the services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales/use taxes and any other additional taxes for the City of Tallassee. This Resolution is effective July 1, 2018.

Effective with your taxes for the tax period ending July 31, 2018, which are due on or before August 20, 2018, the City of Tallassee's sales tax will be administered by:

Resolution #2018- 576

Whereas, City of Tallassee, Alabama desires to begin self-collection and administration of City Sales/Use, Rental, Lodging Tax, and any other additional taxes effective beginning the period of July 1, 2018 (with the first collection to be received on or before August 20, 2018); and

Whereas, City of Tallassee, Alabama has been presented a proposal by RDS of Birmingham dated April 10, 2018, whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the City and the City desires to accept such proposal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Tallassee Council that the City agrees to begin collecting City sales/use, lodging and rental tax effective beginning with the period of July 1, 2018 and the Mayor is instructed to notify the State of Alabama Department of Revenue immediately of the decision of this Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposal presented by RDS dated April 10, 2018, whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the City, be accepted and the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter a contract with RDS which conforms to such proposal.

THEREFORE, Darrell Wilson, a Council member, made the motion and Jeremy Taunton, a Council member, seconded the motion that said resolution be approved, and said resolution passed by majority vote of the Council, and the Mayor declared the Resolution so passed.
