The governing body of the City of Waterloo has adopted Ordinance No. 2015-002 discontinuing the services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales and use tax for the City of Waterloo. This Ordinance is effective December 1, 2015.

Therefore, your last City of Waterloo sales tax return filed with the Alabama Department of Revenue is for the tax period ending November 30, 2015 due on or before December 21, 2015.

Effective with your taxes for the tax period ending December 31, 2015, which are due on or before January 20, 2016, please remit the City of Waterloo's sales tax to:

City of Waterloo Resolution

Resolution No. 2015-002

Whereas, City of Waterloo, Alabama desires to begin self-collection and administration of City Sales/Use Tax and any other additional taxes effective beginning the period of December, 2015 (with the first collection to be received on or before January 20, 2016); and

Whereas, City of Waterloo, Alabama has been presented a proposal by RDS of Birmingham dated October 14, 2015 whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the City and the City desires to accept such proposal.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Waterloo Council that the City agrees to begin collecting City sales/use tax effective beginning with the period of December, 2015 and the Mayor is instructed to notify the State of Alabama Department of Revenue immediately of the decision of this Council; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposal presented by RDS dated 10 - 14, 2015, whereby RDS will perform the services necessary to administer and collect the taxes for the City, be accepted and the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter a contract with RDS which conforms to such proposal.


