- 1) Scholarships for Kids, Inc. had 906 repeat scholarships granted for 2015-2016
- 2) Scholarships for Kids, Inc. had 163 new students that were either 5k or homeschool students that are not mentioned above. (total scholarships granted 1,456 906 (repeats) 120 (non-public) 267 (public) = 162)
- 3) Scholarships for Kids, Inc. only funded fall semester scholarships as of 9/30/15, spring semester funds will be disbursed in December 2015, with adjustments made for withdrawn students.
- 4) 4th student % on new scholarship receipents is 21.82%
