TO: ALL PERSONS, FIRMS, AND CORPORATIONS making sales at retail and/or purchasing tangible personal property for use, storage or other consumption, engaged in the business of leasing or renting tangible personal property, engaged in the renting or furnishing of rooms, lodgings, or accommodations made to transients, in the City of Union Springs, Alabama (located in Bullock County).

Article 3, Chapter 51, Title 11, et seq., Code of Alabama, 1975 authorizes and empowers municipalities to levy a true sales, use, rental and lodgings tax identical to the corresponding State Tax Laws except for the rates of tax.

The governing body of the City of Union Springs has adopted Resolution No. 2024-01 to commence services rendered by the Alabama Department of Revenue in the administration and collection of the sales/use taxes, rental taxes, lodging taxes, for the City of Union Springs. This Resolution is effective September 01, 2024.

Therefore, your first City of Union Springs local tax return filed with Alabama Department of Revenue is for the tax period ending September 30, 2024, which is due on or before October 21, 2024. These taxes are to be reported using the Local Tax return in My Alabama Taxes (MAT) at <https://myalabamataxes.alabama.gov>. **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALABAMA
DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO ADMINISTER AND
COLLECT SALES, USE, RENTAL, AND LODGINGS TAXES
LEVIED BY THE CITY OF UNION SPRINGS, AL**

STATE OF ALABAMA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF UNION SPRINGS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Administration and Collection by Alabama Department of Revenue. Pursuant to the provisions of the Code of Alabama 1975, Section 11-51-207, the City of Union Springs hereby directs that the Department of Revenue of the State of Alabama shall administer and collect all sales, use, rental, and lodgings taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution to the fullest extent allowed by Alabama law.


SECTION 2. Certified Copy. The City of Union Springs shall provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Alabama Department of Revenue and shall also provide such other information and take such other steps as may be required by said Department of Revenue to enable it to administer and collect taxes levied and assessed under the provisions of this Resolution.

The City of Union Springs adopted this Resolution at the regular meeting on May 20, 2024.

This Resolution is effective as of September 1, 2024.
